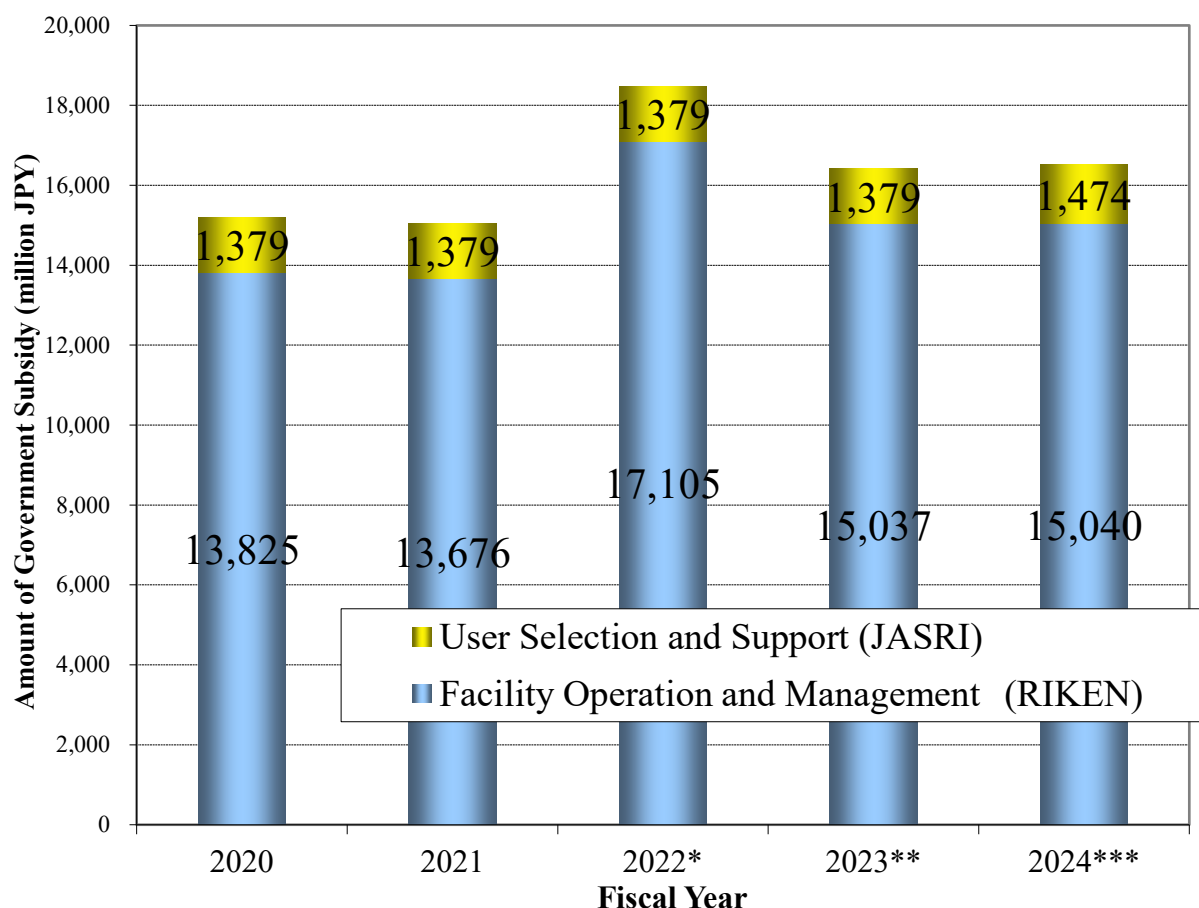


## Budget

RIKEN established Specific Synchrotron Radiation Facilities (SPring-8 and SACLA) and is responsible for their operation and maintenance. JASRI selects and supports users of these facilities under the "Act on the Promotion of Public Utilization of the Specific Advanced Large Research Facilities." To undertake this business, RIKEN and JASRI receive a government subsidy, as shown below.



\*The 2022 budget includes an additional subsidy of 3,429 million JPY for facility operation and management.

\*\*The 2023 budget includes an additional subsidy of 1,361 million JPY for facility operation and management.

\*\*\*The 2024 budget includes an additional subsidy of 700 million JPY for facility operation and management.

In addition to the above, the initial FY2024 budget includes 300 million JPY allocated as "SPring-8 Advanced Development Costs" under the SPring-8-II-related budget.

Furthermore, a total of 49.9 billion JPY in government funding has been approved for the upgrade to SPring-8-II over the five-year period through FY2028, with 17 billion JPY allocated as the initial year's budget for FY2024.
